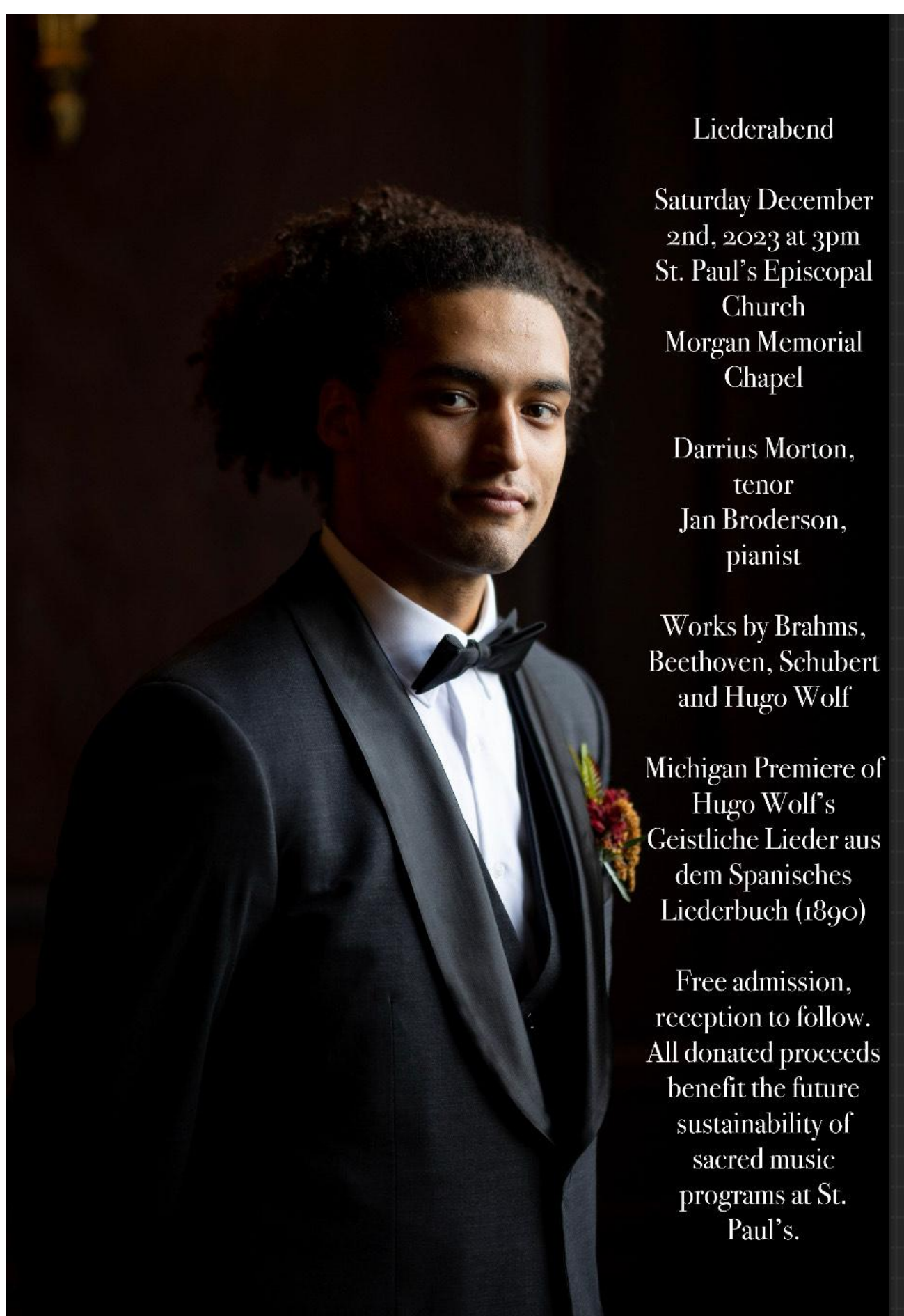
### Think Scrip!
