"IN 2021, EVIDENCE OF UNMARKED GRAVES NEAR AN INDIAN RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL RUN BY THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IN CANADA SPARKED A NATIONAL OUTCRY ABOUT THE FORCED SEPARATION, ASSIMILATION, AND ABUSE MANY CHILDREN EXPERIENCED AT THIS NETWORK OF SEGREGATED BOARDING SCHOOLS DESIGNED TO SLOWLY DESTROY THE CULTURE AND SOCIAL FABRIC OF INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES. SET AMIDST A GROUND-BREAKING INVESTIGATION INTO ABUSE AND DEATH AT AN INDIAN RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL, THE FILM EMPOWERS PARTICIPANTS TO BREAK CYCLES OF INTERGENERATIONAL TRAUMA BY BEARING WITNESS TO PAINFUL, LONG-IGNORED TRUTHS - AND THE LOVE THAT ENDURES WITHIN THEIR FAMILIES DESPITE THE REVELATION OF GENOCIDE."

Sociology teaches us that people like us better when we ask them to do something for us. So here we are...ASKING.

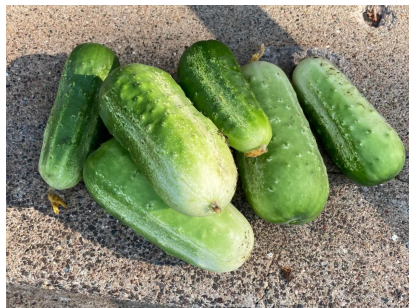
What would you like to do? How would you like to be part of who we are and what we do?
